Camathias Cup



Camathias Cup – European Classic Sidecar Championship.

After much hard work and discussions a European Classic Sidecar Championship will be held in 2013 under the name of the “Camathias Cup”

It will be run as a National Team and Individual Championship.

The aim is that it will be run over 5/6 meeting around Northern Europe

For 2013 several of the races will be incorporated into existing races and the rest will be Camathias only races.

Croix – There will be no Camathias only race and will be part of the races organised by the Ostend Club and points awarded by your finishing positions with other Camathias only registered teams and not the whole grid. Race entry forms are available on the Club web site www.ostendmotorsport.be

Pre TT - there will be a Camathias (again registered only teams) race (You will get a 2nd race with the Pre TT races either Saturday or Monday afternoon (none point scoring races)) Race entry forms are available on the Club web site www.southern100.com

Oulton Park - this is with BEMSEE and is for Camathias only registered teams Race entry forms will be available soon

Assen - Is for Camathias only registered teams. Race entry forms are available soon

Chimay – Currently there is planned to have a Camathias only race at Chimay details currently been sorted.

Gedinne - There will be no Camathias only race and will be part of the races organised by the CRMB and points awarded by your finishing positions with other Camathias only registered teams and not the whole grid

Only registered teams will score points for the Cup.

There may be some space at some meetings that will allow for some wildcards entries but you will need to pay a registration fee which will be reduced from the £50/€60 to £15/€20 per event

Registered only teams will be sent entry forms for the Camathias only rounds and there will be no other way of entering these races.

We will be also looking for feedback from you the Teams as the only way we can build upon this year and learn from what went well and was not so good and take it in to 2014 and beyond is by feedback from you the participants.

We have tried to make sure that the dates do not clash with other Classic Sidecar events BUT this is not always possible so sorry in advance if any have clashed.

RULES

- The Races will be run in two separate classes: Group 1 up to 750cc and Group 2 over 750cc (See separate eligibility rules) Classic bikes only.
- Anyone found with oversize motors will be excluded from the results unless they have stated they have change their motor's before the race, in which case they will score points in the 'other' class.

- Camathias Cup points as follows – 1st-25, 2nd-20, 3rd-16, 4th-13, 5th-11, 6th-10, 7th-9, 8th-8, 9th-7, 10th-6, 11th-5, 12th-4, 13th-3, 14th-2, 15th-1
- Point tables will be updated after each round and sent to the registered teams. Special awards presented at the end of the season.
- Team Event – This will be a bit like the old match races and members of each team will be picked once the entries for each meetings have been confirmed.
- Priority for entries will be given to the Team's who have signed up for the Season They will be sent to them before being opened out to any wildcard entry's

Registered teams must pay the registration fee of £50/€60 for the season.

Points will count individually and towards their country's overall tally depending on driver's nationality.

You must register with country that you are from.

Wildcards must also register to be able to get entry forms for the races they would like to take part in the fee will be dependant on the number of rounds you wish to compete in.

Registration fees will contribute to the series prize fund at the end of the year, and or trophy's throughout the season where a race sponsor has not been obtained and a small fee will also go towards the costs incurred by the organisers.

Committee / Organisers

- The national delegates will form a committee whose decisions are final regarding any disputes, Details of the make up of this are been worked out at this moment. When details are confirmed these will be sent out to all registered teams.
- All teams should register as soon as possible as entry forms will be available very soon for Oulton Park and Assen.
